HB 2010

(Chapter 272) Flags; Homeowners' Associations

Adds a first responder flag and a blue or gold star flag to flags that a unit owner's association or planned community association (Association) may not restrict the outdoor display of.

HB2010 was signed by the Governor on June 06, 2022. ARS Title affected: 33

HB 2131

(Chapter 101) Artificial Grass Ban Prohibited; HOAs

States that a planned community association may not prohibit installing or using artificial grass on a member's property.

HB 2131 was signed by the Governor on March 30, 2022, ARS Title affected: 33

HB 2158

(Chapter 125) Homeowners' Associations; Political; Community Activity

Stipulates that a unit owner's association or a planned community association (Association) may not prohibit a unit owner or member (member) from peacefully assembling and using private or common elements of the community.

HB 2158 was signed by the Governor on April 13, 2022. ARS Title affected: 33
