Fee Waiver Request

- 1. If the individual is applying for a specific license in this state for the first time, an agency, including the Arizona Department of Real Estate, must waive any fee charged for that initial license for:
 - Any individual applicant whose family income does not exceed 200% of the federal poverty guidelines
 - Any active Duty Military Service Member's Spouse
 - Any Honorably Discharged Veteran who has been Discharged Not More than 2 years before Application
- 2. Eligible applications for first time license fee waivers include:
 - Original Real Estate Salesperson License
 - Original Cemetery Salesperson License
 - Original Membership Campground Salesperson License
 - Original Real Estate Broker License
- Original Cemetery Broker License
- Original Membership Campground Broker License
- Original Temporary Salesperson License
- Original Real Estate Recovery Fund Fee
- 3. Applicants may wish to review the following before submitting a **Fee Waiver Request** and may be required to submit additional substantiating documents to the Arizona Department of Real Estate:
 - a. ADRE Fee Schedule, <u>click here</u>
 - b. Arizona Real Estate Sales and Brokers Handbook, click here
 - c. If submitting a Fee Waiver for Low Income Applicants, the Department of Real Estate will work with the Arizona Department of Revenue to verify eligibility. Applicants may:
 - i. <u>Click here</u> to determine whether an Arizona Tax Return has been completed.
 - ii. <u>Click here</u> to review the federal poverty level.
 - d. If submitting the Fee Waiver for an Active Duty Military Service Member's Spouse, a copy of a DEERS Record will be required to demonstrate that the applicant is the spouse of an Activity Duty Service Member. More information may be found <u>here</u>.
 - e. If submitting the Fee Waiver for an Honorably Discharged Veteran who has been Discharged Not More than Two Years before Application, a copy of the Veteran's DD-214: Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty will be required. More information may be found <u>here</u>.
- 4. Applicants must submit a complete application for licensure with all supporting documentation in conjunction with the **Fee Waiver Request**.
- 5. Applicants should complete the form on page 2 and send it and any required documentation to the Department under the Licensing Section of the Message Center by choosing "Submit a Salesperson/Broker application," click here to submit.

The Arizona Department of Real Estate requires proof the applicant is currently listed as the Spouse of an Active Duty Service Member by providing a copy of the Member's DEERS (Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System) Record.	Complete this section and include required documentation to qualify for the Fee Waiver for an Honorably Discharged Veteran (discharged no more than 2 years before application) for a specific license in this state for the first time. The Arizona Department of Real Estate requires proof the applicant was Honorably Discharged within the last 2 years by submitting their DD-214: Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty.	 By checking this box and signing below, I voluntarily: 1.) Attest that to the best of my knowledge and belief, my family income does not exceed two hundred percent of the federal poverty level1; and, 2.) Acknowledge that if I am determined to be ineligible for the fee waiver, I must pay the required fee within 15 days. 3.) Authorize the Arizona Department of Revenue to disclose confidential information to the Arizona Department of Real Estate to verify that my family's reported income meets the requirements for a fee waiver pursuant to A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 6, Article 7.2 upon receipt of the following information:
