


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- NOTE:**
- The Arizona real estate department shall have and make available to the public on request a map showing the exterior boundaries of each territory in the vicinity of a public airport. "Territory in the vicinity of a public airport" means property that is within the traffic pattern airspace as defined by the federal aviation administration and includes property that experiences a day-night average sound level of sixty-five decibels or higher at Springerville Municipal Airport (A.R.S. § 28-8486).
 - The traffic patterns shown in this exhibit are grouped as follows:
 - Zone A - Runway Protection Zone (RPZ)
 - Zone B - Approach Zone (AZ)
 - Zone C - Traffic Pattern Zone (TPZ)
 - Noise contours are not readily available.
 - Refer to FAA Land Use Compatibility Guidelines for additional information.
