UPDATE: <u>Updated Form ED-102 Will Allows For a 4-Year Approval For New Courses</u> with Additional Delivery Methods

BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 25, 2020

- <u>Discard all prior blank ED-102 Forms</u> ADRE will not accept the old version of the ED-102 application form.
- The new ED-102 Form (CE/DL/HR/OPCW) The new ED-102 form must be used for all *new* course applications, with a course approval application and include an Addendum for each delivery method application being applied for. A new course number will be assigned with a four (4) year course expiration date (i.e. All course delivery methods, will be under the same course number). A course may have an approval for multiple delivery methods, depending on the Addenda attached to the application.
- Already approved, current Courses, where a new and/or additional delivery method is desired, can be submitted by completing the new ED-102, including the current course title and course number, and any additional delivery method addenda that were not included on the original course application approval. Upon ADRE approval, the current course number will remain and the course, course number, and all delivery methods will expire on the date stated in the original course approval. A new application will then be required, and a new course number will be assigned with a new four (4) year expiration date. Current approved courses cannot be renewed upon expiration.
- Classroom Salesperson and/or Broker Pre Licensing courses must have been approved on the Salesperson ED-110 and/or Broker ED-112 prior to submitting the new ED-102 and Addendum C for Host Remote delivery approval.

UPDATE: INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP (IDW)

The Department of Real Estate is now accepting applications for Arizona Schools to teach Instructor Development Workshops (IDW) for instructors that deliver Host Remote Live Streaming Pre Licensing and Continuing Education. Approved Arizona Schools should submit their IDW application on Form ED-107 through the Online Message Center, click here, for review and approval.

Proof of attendance at an ADRE approved IDW specific to Host Remote Live Streaming delivery is required for all Arizona instructors that teach Continuing Education and Pre Licensing through the Host Remote delivery method.

UPDATE: Conditional and Temporary Host Remote Live Streaming Course Delivery

The temporary Host Remote Live Streaming course process will continue for October through the existing approval process.

As of September 17, 2020, ADRE has approved 234 Temporary Host/Remote conversions for September delivery.

On September 23rd, ADRE will begin to conditionally approve temporary Host/Remote conversion Addendum Applications for September classroom courses that were scheduled on the ADRE 14 Day Notice online system prior to **September 30th**, **2020**. Please remember that only the specific course title that was scheduled on the same specific date will be temporarily and conditionally approved at this time. Conditional and Temporary Host Remote conversion approvals are valid through the course completion approval date, and ADRE will address each month individually.

Pre License Schools may apply for Host/Remote Classroom Approval

On a temporary and conditionally approved basis, video conferencing technology (example: Google, Zoom, etc.) can be used to deliver October Live classroom Pre Licensing Courses that have been scheduled in the ADRE 14 Day Notice online system prior to **September 30, 2020.**

REMEMBER TO SCHEDULE ALL OCTOBER COURSES YOU PLAN TO OFFER IN OCTOBER ON THE ADRE 14 DAY NOTICE BY SEPTEMBER 30th, click here

Continue to complete the new Addendum to the ED-110-PE (Salesperson) or ED-112-PE (Broker) for ADRE approval of the Host/Remote Course, and include your currently approved and already scheduled Pre Licensing course.

- Please be sure to submit the already approved ED-110-PE or ED-112-PE with the Addendum.
- ADRE staff will review your Addendum for approval as promptly as possible.

<u>Already Scheduled Live Classroom Continuing Education (CE) may apply for Conditional</u> and Temporary Host/Remote Classroom Approval

On a conditional and temporarily approved basis, video conferencing technology (example: Google, Zoom, etc.) can be used to deliver October Live Classroom Continuing Education (CE) Courses, that have scheduled on the ADRE 14 Day Notice online system prior to **September 30**, **2020**.

Continue to complete the new Addendum to the ED-102 for ADRE approval of the Host/Remote Course, and submit your currently approved and already scheduled continuing course outline.

- ADRE staff will review your Addendum for approval as promptly as possible.

<u>Please Remember</u>: Schools must submit a new 14 Day Notice through the ADRE Online System, <u>click here</u>, to ensure courses are listed correctly on the ADRE Public Database. <u>This</u> includes course cancellations.
