Instructor Renewal January Examination Statistics Request #2 for Input

Instructor Renewal

Instructor renewal notices are sent to the instructor's Sponsor school; not the instructor directly. Schools are encouraged to work with their Instructors to start early on the renewal process since they have up to 90 days prior to their expiration date to apply for renewal.

The application and all other required documents should be combined into one pdf and uploaded into the ADRE Message Center.

Additional information needed with the ED-101 application for renewal:

- IDW- attach a copy of the certificate
- CE certificates- attach copies of all of the certificates
- Proof of Legal Presence in the US (copy of front and back)
 - Documents acceptable to meet the requirements of A.R.S. § 41-1080 (Proof of Legal Presence) are listed at www.azre.gov.

 - Salesperson: 50%


